

## West Yorkshire and Harrogate Support Staff Workforce Development Funding (SSWDF) 2019/20

Health Education England have confirmed that the 2019/20 Support Staff Workforce Development Fund (SS WDF) is now agreed and will be released to successful bids across the 6 West Yorkshire and Humber (WYH) locality areas for use before the end of March 2020.

Applications are open to any Health or Social Care Organisation responsible for delivering services as part of the WYH integrated Care system and must reflect a plan aimed at benefiting support staff roles.

Applications must demonstrate an advantage to the Health & Care system and ways of working. A plan should be included outlining how impact would be evaluated and shared.

Proposed costs should be quantified and where applicable reference should be made where other sources of funding are also being used.
